Presentation on the proposed Vista Del Rey project at 12604 Culver Blvd (Culver/Braddock)

**Matt Halden / CD11**

Proposed Vista Del Rey project: CD11 has met with the developers. SB4 takes a lot of control out of our hands. CD11 has encouraged them to do community outreach, and in general, CD11 is supportive of affordable housing, with community input. Email CD11 for any questions on their position.

Safety meetings (re: Vista Motel) are continuing, monthly, with progress being made. Since some RVs are used as dwellings, the enforcement is very different and involves a formal process.

CD11 has gotten a dedicated CARE+ team; they will assist with trash but cannot do anything about vehicles. In order to send out homelessness services to address encampments, photos and other documentation are useful for getting resources. However, if it isn't possible, let Matt know so he can try to document. Keep in mind that if they don't want to move and are living in their vehicle, there isn't much CD11 can do.

405/Braddock encampment is growing and CD11 is aware of this. Operation is planned for Wednesday; for the vehicles, another CAO operation will be conducted in the near future. The next CAO operation will be Inglewood/90, Mesmer/90, or 405/Braddock; these are the focus areas for CAO operations.

CD11 is continuing to work with CALTRANS to address encampments along the 90 (such as medians, embankments, etc). It is challenging to get into some of the areas, and also many fire crews have been redirected due to the wildfires.

CD11 is collaborating with Culver City and other jurisdictions/agencies to address homelessness issues. Many jurisdictions == more complicated operations.

A Culver Median clean up was conducted last Wednesday to address trash and palm fronds. Matt is hoping to continue clean ups every other week.

Parks need assessment - will be held on Wednesday in Westchester.
